## Barato L. Britt named President of EMCC Holdings LLC and Chief Executive Officer of Edna Martin Christian Center Inc.

INDIANAPOLIS— The Edna Martin Christian Center Board of Directors has named Barato L. Britt, current VP of EMCC and Executive Director of its Leadership & Legacy Campus, the new President of Edna Martin Christian Center Holdings LLC and Chief Executive Officer of Edna Martin Christian Center Inc. The transition will be effective January 1, 2020.

Barato succeeds Tysha Hardy-Sellers who after more than 11 years of service to EMCC will join the Lilly Endowment Inc. on January 6.

Barato will be the  $5^{th}$  leader of EMCC after Edna Barnes Martin over the agency's 80-year history.

Having an extensive community service and community development background, Barato brings 11 years of experience from his executive positions at EMCC; Executive Director experience from the Indiana chapter of Black Alliance for Educational Options Inc.; and more than 25 years of experience in community engagement, partnership development, advocacy, grant writing, politics, strategic planning, staff support, and journalism.

Most recently, as Executive Director of the Leadership and Legacy Campus (a property under EMCC Holdings, LLC), Barato helped lead efforts to revitalize 13 acres of property. Through a unique partnership with KIPP Indy Public Schools and Shepherd Community Inc., the EMCC leadership team, board, and local and federal funding sources, he helped secure nearly \$15 million in combined investments for the campus within a 2-year period, while also working with the EMCC team to maintain programming and service delivery.
